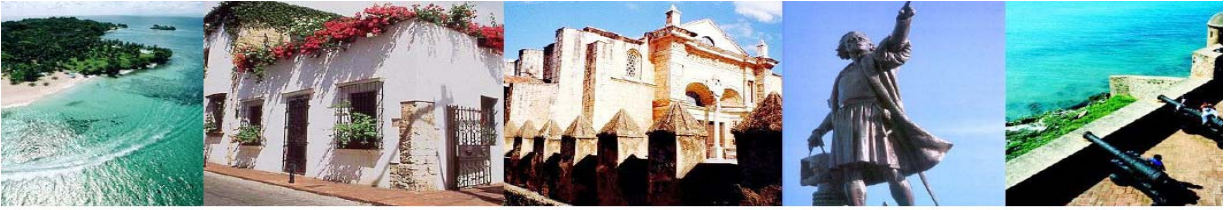


DOMINICAN REPUBLIC TOURS - GROUP PACKAGES: HISTORY TOUR

A little taste of Dominican Culture and Adventure!

day 1 Arrival

Arrival to the Airport. Transfer with drinks included to Juan Dolio in a comfortable air-conditioned coach. Accommodation in a Hotel in the Juan Dolio area.

day 2 Catalina Island (full day)

On the second day we depart to the port of La Romana, (1.5 hours from Punta Cana) to start a unique excursion in a Catamaran with fun, merengue and rum. In the morning we will visit the town Altos the Chavon. Built in 1970 it's a perfect replica of a 16th century Spanish town. We will take a catamaran to anchor in front of Catalina Island where you will take speedboats to get to the island. Once you arrive you can swim the Caribbean crystalline waters, snorkel and taste a delicious lunch with fresh lobsters, fish and drinks included. In the afternoon we will pass through the Chavon River inside an amphibious vehicle. Return in the evening to the hotel.

day 3 Rafting – Jarabacoa (full day)

On the third day, we depart early in the morning to experience a great adventure that will be fun for everyone. Hop on a raft and enjoy the cool waters of Yaque del Norte River, the largest in the Caribbean. Escorted by professional guides experience the adrenaline rush as you navigate through canyons and rapids. You will discover little known places. Basic training and essential equipment: A wetsuit, Life jackets, Boots and Protective helmet are included. Breakfast, snacks and lunch are included. Return in the evening to the hotel.

day 4 Saona Island (full day)

On the fourth day we depart to the port of Bayahibe, (1 hour from Juan Dolio) to start the full day excursion to Saona Island, the biggest island near to the Dominican Republic part of the Eastern National Park, a nature reserve filled with the explosive beauty of the local flora & fauna. There are two ways of reaching Saona Island, by fast launch and in a Catamaran. On your way to the island you will enter small lagoons of crystal waters, a perfect setting for a refreshing dip and to observe colorful starfish. On the beach the crew will prepare and serve a delicious lunch, and afterwards there will be time to stretch your legs swim or simply relax and enjoy the incomparable beauty of the setting. Return in the evening to the hotel.

day 5 Parque Nacional Los Haitises (full day)

We depart early in the morning to enjoy the national park of Los Haitises, located at the western end of the bay on the south shore across from Sanchez. This park features mangrove swamps with giant mangrove trees forming a lush, green canopy above the watery trails that wind through the swamps. All guests are interested in history, fauna, and flora and especially in the beauty of this region will enjoy this trip. When we arrive in Sabana de la Mar we will board a boat that will carry us through more magnificent mangroves and a visit to caves once inhabited by Tainos 500 years ago. Lunch included. Return in the evening to the Hotel.

day 6 Santo Domingo (full day)

We depart on a comfortable air-conditioned coach to the Capital city of the Dominican Republic, which features an important historical and cultural legacy. From Tres Ojos (three eyes cave) – formerly used as a public swimming pool, to the Cathedral, Las Damas Street and the Alcázar de Colon. A journey through a 16th century neighborhood that is considered to be the most ancient of all the cities in the Americas. Time for shopping! This tour includes guided visits to the historical monuments, lunch and refreshments. We remind you that revealing clothing is not allowed in the Cathedral and therefore you should wear long trousers or skirts for women. Return to the Hotel.

day 7 Departure

Transfers to the airport with soft drinks included.
