day 1 Arrival

Arrival to the Airport. Transfer to Punta cana in a comfortable air-conditioned coach with drinks included. Accommodation in a Hotel of the area.

day 2 Catalina Island (full day)

On the second day we depart to the port of La Romana, (1.5 hours from Punta Cana) to start a unique excursion in a Catamaran with fun, merengue and rum. In the morning we will visit the town Altos the Chavon. Built in 1970 it's a perfect replica of a 16th century Spanish town. We will take a catamaran to anchor in front of Catalina Island where you will take speedboats to get to the island. Once you arrive you can swim the Caribbean crystalline waters, snorkel and taste a delicious lunch with fresh lobsters, fish and drinks included. In the afternoon we will pass through the Chavon River inside an amphibious vehicle. Return in the evening to the Hotel.

day 3 Monster Truck - Punta Cana (half day)

On the third day we depart from your hotel to the Monster Truck parking in Higüey, located 52kms from Punta Cana (Bavaro). Let the adventure start! We start by visiting a Dominican rural family at their home. Where you will learn about the way of life of the country people. You will enjoy fresh brewed coffee from hand ground beans and shown around their house, be amazed at just how many people can live in such a small house and still keep everything neat and clean; simple but beautiful. Afterwards we visit a fruit plantation where you will learn about the planting, marketing and profit of the plantation. Enjoy the fruits of the plantation for yourself. We continue by visiting a small, remote community a long way from any city with a church, school or "colmado" (local grocery store). Finally a Dominican buffet awaits you where you will have time to relax before the next stop of our trip. Each truck carries beer, soft-drinks, water, or drinks mixed with rum, served to you by our professional staff. Return to the hotel.

day 4 Crazy Wheel - Punta Cana (half day)

Transfer by minibus from the hotel to the quad base. Each team then takes possession of their quad machines, and learns the simple handling of the machine which takes just minutes to explain. An excellent opportunity to discover the Dominican countryside and have fun at the same time. You will drive through different terrains from asphalt to land roads, jungle paths and of course the beach. This excursion leads you to discover the country village Macao and gives you the opportunity to drive a 4x4 semi automatic motorcycle across one of the most beautiful beaches in the Dominican Republic: the Macao beach. The itinerary is structured to allow everyone to familiarize themselves with riding this kind of vehicles through an easy terrain that gradually gets harder. Nevertheless this excursion is suitable for all members of the family. Back to the hotel for lunch and rest of the day free.

day 5 Santo Domingo (full day)

On the fifth day, we depart in a comfortable air-conditioned coach to the Capital city of the Dominican Republic, which features an important historical and cultural legacy. From Tres Ojos (three eyes cave) – formerly used as a public swimming pool, to the Cathedral, Las Damas Street and the Alcázar de Colon. A journey through a 16th century neighborhood that is considered to be the most ancient of all the cities in the Americas. Time for shopping!

This tour includes guided visits to the historical monuments, lunch and refreshments. We remind you that revealing clothing is not accepted in the Cathedral and you should wear long trousers or skirts for women. Return to the Hotel.

day 6 Departure

Transfers to the airport with soft drink included.
