### Barcelona Bites

Learn a different side to Spanish culture – it's cuisine. Always balanced and healthy, but rich in variety, Catalan cuisine is one of the best gastronomic examples the Mediterranean region can offer. Not only is Barcelona one of the most famous cities in the world for having great food at incredible value for money, but it's considered the number one city, outside of France, to offer a truly 'Gourmet' standard.

### day 1 A journey through the local gastronomy

Start this trip for your taste buds with dinner in a local restaurant and a selection of different local dishes, including one of the most typical Catalanian plates, toasted bread with tomato and virgin olive oil.

### day 2 Enjoy Barcelona

Continue the journey with a trip through ancient history and a 'photo rally' through the Gothic Quarter. This is a photographic orienteering tour, complete with roadbooks and maps, including a visit to one of the most typical markets in Barcelona – the Boqueria. Situated at the world famous Ramblas, the market dates back to the 13th century, covers 6000 m2 and is home to more than 300 stalls (vegetables, fruits, meats, fish,...).

And don't forget the cooking? Ever tried to cook a typical "Paella," well here's your chance (properly dressed of course, complete with chef's outfit)... and then the most important part -you get to eat it!

Then more food after some free time, with dinner in a typical Tapas Restaurant to sample everything from spanish omelette, to fried squid Andalusian style, different types of Iberian Cured Ham and sausages, all washed down with local wines.

### day 3 The cava

This culinary experience wouldn't be complete without a visit to our local cellars. So for the last day, it's off to a typical catalan cellar where "Cava" (the local Catalan sparkling wine) is made. Cavas Codorniu was founded in 1551 and boasts more than 30 kilometres of underground galleries on five levels, making it the most extensive subterranean cellar in the world.

We take a train to travel through the caves, while a guide explains the complete wine-making process, from the selection of the different kind of grapes, to the pressing and removing the stalks and impurities, ending with the fermentation at low temperatures for each grape variety. Of course you have to finish the tour with a sample!
