Willing to enjoy bulls, horses and sherry?

day 1 Seville - Panoramic visit

Arrive at the airport, through immigration and on to visit the Square of Spain, site of the Ibeamerican Exposition of 1929 and the Maria Luisa Park. Then on by foot, to tour the Jewish district of Santa Cruz before we continue along the river Guadalquivir, to see the Golden Tower, the bull-ring in front of the Triana district and reach the ancient Expo site of 1992, now a theme Park. We finish the day at the Macarena church with a Fried Fish dinner. Then transfer to the hotel, accommodation, and free time.

day 2 Seville - Jerez

Breakfast and departure from the hotel to Jerez. The city is well known for three things - bulls, horses and sherry, the latter unique to the region because of the climate and chalky soil, ideal for palomino grapes. Indeed the name of the city is the Spanish word for sherry.

Visit its internationally known bodegas or Wine Cellars to see the tradition process of aging the sherry in oaken barrels, a tradition that has been followed for centuries. And, of course, you might want to try a sample.

Lunch in a typical bar.

Visit the Andalusian Royal Equestrian School, and if you are there on a Thursday, you'll have the chance to see the "horse ballet", a combination of classical and country dressage, with music, horses and riders in a harmonious and colourful symphony of motion.

Visit the Andalusian Carriage Museum. Carriages also form an important part of equestrian art. In 1986 the Royal School acquired the splendid Equestrian Bequet of coaches and Carriages of Don Pedro Domecq de la Riva, comprising a priceless collection of 40 pure Spanish horses and 22 beautifully decorated carriages. The collection includes the famous coach used at the recent wedding of HRH Princess Elena in Seville.

We'll take a "Tapa's trail" for dinner in typical restaurants and bars of Seville.

Return to the hotel.

day 3 Country farm visit

Breakfast and departure from the hotel to the country farm.

Cortijo la Calera is located just 40 km from Seville at the north of the city, where the farm, belonging to the family Lora Sangran, specializes in rearing bulls. We can witness an impressive display of bull ranching, covering everything from birth to how the bull is reared into adulthood. We can also take part of the tour by 4x4. Aperitives are taken in the gardens and lunch in the main lounge. There's also the chance to see a mock bullfight with a young bull.

We're then off for dinner and a genuine Flamenco show, at a local hacienda.

Return to the the hotel and free time.

day 4 Departure

Breakfast. Free time and transfer to the airport.
