# WINE ROUTE THROUGH THE SOUTH OF SPAIN

**Day 1 MALAGA AIRPORT – COSTA DEL SOL**  
Arrival to Málaga Airport. Assistance at the Airport, and transfer by bus to hotel in Costa del Sol. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

**Day 2 COSTA DEL SOL – OJÉN – PUERTO DE SANTA MARÍA**  
Breakfast at hotel. Meeting with bus and escort guide in hotel, and departure towards Ojén, where the group will visit the Wine Shop-Museum. Continuation to Puerto de Santa María, little fishing village in Cadiz in the past ages. Time for lunch (not included).  
Arrival, and visit to a wine cellar, where it is produced the wine known as "fino". Accommodation in hotel. Dinner-overnight at hotel.

**Day 3 PUERTO DE SANTA MARÍA – JEREZ – SANLÚCAR – SEVILLE**  
Breakfast at hotel. Departure to Jerez, famous for because the "Sherry" wine, and horses. Arrival to Jerez, and visit to this village including a visit to the Royal Andalusian School of Equestrian Art (only trainings), and a guided visit to a Sherry wine cellar there. Time for lunch (not included).  
Continuation to the village of Sanlucar de Barrameda, famous for many reasons: its wine, called "Manzanilla", its prawns, its summer horse

racos over the extensive sandy beaches, and a wealth of fine buildings, as the Ducal Palace of Medina Sidonia. Visit to a wine cellar there and continuation to Seville.

Arrival, and accommodation in hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

**Day 4 SEVILLE – NIEBLA – LA RÁBIDA – SEVILLE**  
Breakfast at hotel. In the morning, departure from Seville to the province of Huelva. Huelva is the area which is very closely related to the Discovery of America, It was from the long-gone docks of the municipality of Palos de la Frontera that the caravels set sail on 3th August 1.492. We will go first to La Rábida, passing through the village of Niebla, the best preserved Almohade site in Spain, visiting there its Castle, as well as the Santa María de la Granada church, with a tower reminiscent of the Giralda. On arriving to La Rabida, we will visit the Monastery, which is a Gothic-Mudejar church featuring one of the oldest crucifixes in Andalusia, the beautiful Mudejar style cloisters. In the Monastery spent Cristopher Columbus the last days before his departure to the "New World". We will visit also the Dock of the Caravels, where we can admire a copy of these ships.  
Time for lunch (not included). Return to Seville. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

**Day 5 SEVILLE – CÓRDOBA**

Breakfast at hotel. In the morning, visit with local guide to Seville, capital of Andalucía, internationally renowned, which has been completely renovated in recent years. It has an impressive monumental heritage, and a rich and varied festive calendar centred around the Holy Week and the April Fair. We will visit first the Cathedral, one of the world's biggest Christian places of worship (its the third biggest one, after St. Peter in Rome, and St. Paul in London), as well as the Giralda, arabic minaret which has become a universal Christian tower. We continue with a visit to another monumental complex: the arabic "Alcazar", which was extended by Peter I, Peter the Cruel, which is predominantly in a painstakingly worked Mudejar style, and where the gardens are essential counterpoint. Finishing visit, time for lunch (not included). Departure to Córdoba. On arriving there, we will visit one of the most famous monuments all over the world: the Mosque-Cathedral. The only one of its kind in Europe, it is a lavish arabic building with house within it a Cathedral with Gothic, Plateresque and Baroque elements. The art of Caliphate finds its culmination in this mosque which until this century was the third largest in the world, and which has quite rightly been declared part of the World Heritage of Humanity. We will make also a walking tour through the narrow streets of its ancient jewish quarter, where we can admire that was once the Sinagogue. Finishing visit, accommodation in hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

and we continue to Granada. Time for lunch (not included). Arrival to Granada. There are few cities which have such a dense history so well-reflected in its many monuments, in its appearance, and in the atmosphere of its daily life. We will visit "La Alhambra", which means "the red castle". It is one of the most beautiful arabic monuments in the world, which thanks to the abundance of fountains and gardens always has a very agreeable temperature. From the emblematic Torre de la Vela, in the area of La Alcazaba, to the Gardens of Generalife, all of this immense complex and its surrounding areas are rich in views of the city, its most characteristic districts and outskirts. Accommodation in Granada. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

**Day 7 GRANADA – MÁLAGA – COSTA DEL SOL**

Breakfast at hotel. Departure from Granada towards Málaga, capital of Costa del Sol. Málaga, was once described by the Nobel Prize winner Vicente Aleixandre, as the City of the Paradise. Málaga is both a commercial city and port, which for many years has had a population of over half a million inhabitants, and enjoys one of the best climated on the European mainland. We will visit its Cathedral, one of the best examples of Spanish Renaissance architecture, an harmonious building despite the fact that one of its two planned towers was never finished. We continue with a visit to a wine cellar in Málaga, where it is produced this popular and sweet wine. Time for lunch (not included). Continuation to Costa del Sol. Accommodation in hotel. Dinner and overnight at hotel.

**Day 6 CÓRDOBA – MONTILLA – GRANADA**

Breakfast at hotel. In the morning, we will depart from Córdoba to Granada, taking the route through the "campiña" (countryside). We will go first to Montilla, capital of this area, as well as capital of wine production, and which was also home of the Gran Capitan. We will visit a wine cellar in Montilla,
